



Luba's long red hair was overgrown with old highlights that had faded. Stylist Brenda Crane of Salon 56 in San Diego, California started a new look by applying a rich Chestnut brown base with soft caramel high-

lights. Next she cut a better length, which just hit Luba's shoulders, and added some shattered layers with a fun peek-a-boo bang.

A dime-size amount of Moroccan oil was worked onto her damp hair and then Joico Thickening Texture Spray was misted on. Brenda blow-dried sections with a medium round brush and then switched to a vent brush to dry the bangs straight down. Goldwell Big Finish Hairspray was applied to 1.5-inch sections, which were then wrapped around a tapered Enzo curling rod. Once all sections were curled, Luba flipped her head upside down and then Brenda ran her fingers through to break up the sections. After flipping right-side up again, a dime-size amount of L'Oreal Architexture was used on her fingers to twist and pinch through the ends for a piece-y finish. *Makeup: Gerine Coronado*
